Courses & Descriptions: K-12

Games & Tournaments

Students compete and cooperate with peers or challenge themselves in solitary play.

They will immerse themselves in many important skills (math, teamwork, organization, negotiation, and more!) through various games (cards, board games, games of action and coordination). Tournaments will run according to interest.

Theatre / Drama

Students may conduct Puppet Shows and/or experience Readers' Theatre; this involves students reading aloud scripts from various grade-level appropriate books or stories to build word knowledge, vocabulary, and fluency. Each student has a part or "lines" in the story. Students will create simple costumes and small props using basic craft materials.

Older Students will learn interdependence, teamwork and increase their individual confidence through learning the basics of on-stage performance.

Art

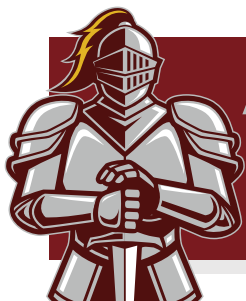
Younger students' projects may include basic art techniques and Arts & Crafts projects.

Older students will be introduced to drawing, painting, and 3-D art concepts and techniques. Varied projects will sharpen students' artistic abilities.

Science

Students will experience labs, learn various scientific concepts incorporating hands-on learning as they discover our physical world.

Gardening: Students will learn the basics of gardening and apply these principles to tend the Co-op's vegetable and flower gardens.

Private tutoring program, available during and after the co-op day.

Culinary

This class is an introduction to the culinary arts. Students will apply measuring skills and learn basic cooking skills, including simple dishes and baking.

The 3 R's

To assist in maintaining traditional academic skills throughout the summer, students will participate in engaging activities involving Reading, WRiting and/or aRithmetic skills.

This class may introduce students to the understanding of a good story's structure; then students will create their own stories.

For the younger students, the class may consist of reading a story and then doing an activity to boost reading comprehension.

Be a Movie Critic!

Our young students may watch a short video as well as read an accompanying story and conduct a Compare & Contrast Analysis.

Older students may watch movies, video clips, and documentaries and learn the skills of critical analysis, while also having the fun of "publishing" their work and making a "magazine/journal" of their work across the course of the summer term. We would use the computers and increase skills in documents and slides, as well as public speaking.

Recess

Students select how to spend their free time, within a safe and supervised environment. They have access to ping pong and air hockey. They may read, play cards, board games, solve puzzles, draw and color or select a more physical activity, such as Catch, Tag "Football", and Basketball, etc.

Physical Education

We will focus on developing the skills of teamwork, sportsmanship, and maintaining a healthy lifestyle through playing various sports and activities, including:

- K-2 students: Tag, Games of Imagination, Softball, Basketball, Soccer, and Dodgeball
- Grades 3 -12: Basketball, Hockey and Dodgeball.
